New First Party Privacy Coverage Available for Non-profit Organizations

CINCINNATI — June 1, 2010 — ALTRU, LLC, a managing general underwriter, introduces an expanded Directors and Officers Liability insurance policy to protect not for profit organizations and their management against liability claims. The coverage is issued by Old Republic Insurance Company, rated A+ by A. M. Best and A+ by Standard & Poor's, and distributed through wholesale and retail insurance brokers throughout the U.S. Melissa Black, Senior Underwriter at ALTRU, said, "We have acted as a managing general underwriter serving non-profit organizations for over 15 years, and Old Republic Insurance company, through its Chicago Underwriting Group, has written Management and Professional Liability for over 25 years. We are excited to enter this new partnership with such a high caliber organization."

New First Party Supplemental Data Breach Coverage

The new policy provides a coverage option in the form of a first party Supplemental Data Breach Endorsement, available on a select basis with a sublimit. Non-profit organizations (Foundations, Trusts, schools, churches, etc.) receive and disburse donations, grants, loans and other financial support electronically, can possess sensitive information of either their supporters or beneficiaries, and are as much a potential target for cyber attack and vulnerable to data breach as any commerce driven organization may be. "We have reviewed the Supplementary Data Breach Expense Coverage (the "Endorsement") being offered as part of Old Republic Insurance Company's Non-Profit Organization Management Liability Insurance Policy. The additional

coverage offered in the Endorsement will, in our view, provide a significant benefit to insureds. I am not aware of any other carrier that offers this benefit as a widely available option for an existing management liability policy,” commented John Scordo, Esq. of the national law firm, Day Pitney LLP, Day Pitney LLP has prepared a “white paper” on the subject of data security breaches and the state notification laws which can be viewed at www.altru.com. “I am getting very positive feedback on the Supplemental Security Breach Endorsement from our broker partners, and it is nice to fill a market need,” Black added.

In addition to managing Employment Practices exposure, management is faced with the threat of suits by donors, local communities and even those being served by the non-profit organization. Beyond broad coverage for these exposures, this new, state of the art policy can include Fiduciary Liability and Workplace Violence coverage. The coverage is available on an admitted basis in 48 states currently.
